
EASSH General Assembly 2023 Overview

2023 in numbers

- Over 50 presentations to large groups of researchers, institutions and member organisation
- Over 30 presentations as invited panel speaker in European-wide conferences (thanks to Board members also for their support)





EASSH 2023-2026: Three years forecast

- ► Focus on designing the conditions to ensure the SSH contribution in the next Framework programme
- Encourage networking meetings between EASSH members for funding opportunities
- Develop capacity for deeper engagement with members
- Increase SSH research questions into specific areas (eg. area studies China and Africa; social policy/employment; twin transition; blue economy; health studies)
- Coordinate a narrative across different continents about SSH research contribution

Mid-term evaluation of Horizon Europe

EASSH in Horizon Europe:



Invited to Lamy's meetings



Worked with a coalition of associations (budget campaign; legal text; etc.)



Technical position papers for SSH inclusion and integration (SSH cluster, higher budget, more funding to ERC)



Focus on contribution of SSH research (beyond SSH cluster)



SSH integration: calls design, evaluations processes, reviewers and monitoring of bottlenecks

- Legal text referring to social, cultural and human aspects in all parts ("a human-centric approach")
- An SSH cluster with €2.1Bn; a new panel in ERC for SSH; more attention to SSH and social impact
- Better understanding of SSH research for integration
- Active and invited to close meeting discussing calls design, evaluations processes, etc.
- The effective integration of SSH in all clusters, including all missions and partnerships, is a principle through the programme cycle. (HE Strategic Plan)

Social transformations and resilience Objectives:

- Strenghthen the knowledge base in Europe and develop innovative solutions to tackle critical social transformations driven by the green and digital transitions, global trade patterns and demographic change
- Provide policymakers at European, national and regional levels with evidence-based recommendations that can inform new strategies and policies to address these societal transformations
- Increase the resilience of EU societies to global crises
- Build capacity among the R&I community and policymakers to respond to long-term socio-economic changes



Impact

- Supporting the modernisation of social protection and inclusive access to essential services, particularly for groups at risk of poverty and social exclusion
- ► Future of work (access to quality jobs, under decent working conditions, re-/up-skilling for the future workforce, innovative job transitions especially in green sectors, new forms of work organisation, gender-equal and inclusive workplaces)
- Fostering education and skills development in the context of the green and digital transition, including EU mobility policies, and help counter socioeconomic and political inequalities, contributing to a comrephensive European strategy for inclusive growth and upwards convergence
- Contributing to a fair transition in line with the Council recommendations on ensuring a fair transiton towards climate neutrality



Brain Health objectives

- Find cures for brain disorders and living with brain diseases through narratives of patients
- ► Enable early diagnosis for early personalised treatments that are affordable and accessible to everyone
- Promote evidence-based prevention at individual and community levels, including family narrative and longitudinal studies
- Optimise the clinical management of affected persons, including identification and diffusion of best practices and standards, structures and cares, health care policies and support for families and carers

Preparation of FP10

- ERAC task force for FP10
- High Level Group of experts EUR rector member of the group
- Ongoing discussions with the Planning Unit
- DG Employment supporting the Social Pillar
- MS not yet aligned on priorities currently France & Italy remain the strongest supporters of SSH research
- Smaller countries and widening countries to be lobbied





ERAC FP10 task force: EASSH key recommendations

- 1. A dedicated and appropriate space for supporting research into challenges to society, culture, and human values.
- 2. An appropriate level of resources comparable to other key priorities with a wider range of intervention areas and a balanced distribution of resources.
- 3. Appropriate representation of SSH expertise throughout FP10, from the initial design of the programme, through to call drafting and project evaluation.
- 4. Regular monitoring of SSH integration also under the next FP.
- 5. Flexibility of project size
- 6. More resources for ERC and pillar two to support bottom-up collaborative projects
- More fundamental Research and Innovation Actions in pillar 2
